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I have truly enjoyed my time spent over the past school year as a Provost Fellow. As I am still fairly new to the University, and also new to higher education so I found it very informative. We Are Not Alone

When I first joined the College of Engineering and Computer Science as an Aviation Lecturer, I felt like we had a wide variety of departments that may not be very connected.
