The Southern Utah University Purchasing Office is formally accepting bids for the sale of a 1968 Chrysler New Yorker automobile. This vehicle was donated to the University and has been kept in storage. Considering the age, the vehicle is in good shape overall. There is no rust or other serious body issues. The motor runs well and most of the systems are operating. The general specifications are as follows:

- 4-door Hardtop – all original
- Original interior (showing typical wear)
- 97,000+ on the odometer
- Power Windows – all work!
- Electric front seat adjustment – works!
- Original AM radio – works!
- Configured for a power aerial but does not work
- Original V-8 engine
- White Wall Tires w/Hub Caps
- **Minimum Bid - \$2,500**

Bids must be sealed and may be mailed or hand delivered, with the project name and number clearly referenced on the envelope, and received in the Southern Utah University Purchasing Office, attention Pete Heilgeist, no later than **2:00 pm, November 20th, 2009**. Bids received late will not be considered.

- Vehicle is being sold “as is” and the University offers no warranties. Upon the sale, the vehicle was functioning as indicated with no known hidden issues. Sale will be final.
- Bids will include the price offered by the bidder for the vehicle.
- Bidders are encouraged to contact the University to review and examine the vehicle prior to the bid due date. Contact Pete Heilgeist, number listed below, for more information.
- If a bidder cannot come to the campus to view the vehicle prior to the bid due date, images can be provided electronically upon request.

- Award of this project shall be made strictly to the highest bidder. If the highest bidder does not claim the vehicle within 10 days after award, the next highest bidder will be notified.
- In the case of a tie bid, each of those bidders will be contacted and given the opportunity to resubmit their bid with an adjusted amount. The award will be given to the high bid received.
- Delivery of the vehicle is not provided. The winning bidder will be responsible to make all arrangements to come to the campus and pick up and transport. Any damage occurring during transportation will be the responsibility of the bidder (buyer).
- Payment will be made when vehicle is picked up.
- Southern Utah University reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids or waive any informality in any bid in the interest of the university.
